PhD candidates are encouraged to follow a PhD Development Training which fits the duration and type of contract of the PhD project. The GSMS invites PhD candidates to shape their learning trajectories by selecting courses and activities based on the competences that they wish to develop (test your competences here). A **certificate from the GSMS** will be handed over when the requirements are met. The GSMS curriculum is based on the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System. While carrying out your PhD project, **European Credit points (ECTS)** must be obtained by taking courses and activities related to the PhD research or one of the competences. One ECTS is equivalent to a workload of 28 hours.

Note: E-learning courses are also permitted up to a maximum of 20% of the required $\ensuremath{\mathsf{ECTS}}$

* For the competence personal effectiveness, only the courses and workshops in the overview will be accepted for a reimbursement of the training budget and awarded with ECTS points.

4. Requirement to have a balanced programme

- Courses: A minimum of 1/3 of the required ECTS must be obtained by taking courses or following summer schools related to the PhD research or one of the competences.
- Activities: A minimum of 1/3 of the required ECTS must be obtained by conducting other PhD research activities or competence related activities (see appendix).
- The remaining of the required ECTS may be collected by a mixture of the two above.

For example: a PhD candidate with a 4 years appointment has obtained 30 ECTS at the end of the PhD project, of which 18 ECTS were obtained by taking courses (min. required 10 ECTS) and 12 ECTS by conducting activities (min. required 10 ECTS).

Requirements PhD students from the research school BCN

BCN PhD students must meet the requirements (including obligatory courses) for the BCN PhD training programme to obtain the BCN certificate. Please consult the BCN website or BCN ring binder.

Need to know / abbreviations

The GSMS has made an overview of courses and activities that are offered to PhD candidates, both internally at the GSMS and elsewhere within the UMCG and UG. All of them are categorized by seven core competences. However, you may also select courses and activities outside this range on offer.

The overview also provides the following additional information:

Preferred phase: Within which phase of my PhD does the course or activity fit? This is a general recommendation only, courses and activities can be taken at any time during your PhD. Only for the obligatory courses there is a strong recommendation.

Provider: PhD candidates can select courses and activities from numerous providers. The provider is mentioned in this column.

Format: The programme consists of a variety of training elements. This can be a course or an activity such as a workshop, symposium, scientific conference or miscellaneous.

Transferable skills: For each course or activity we show whether skills can be acquired which you bring to future employment settings.

ECTS: The amount of European Credit points that can be obtained. This may be variable depending on the workload or whether the PhD candidate also take an exam.

Do I need to pay?

The GSMS courses are offered free of charge for registered PhD candidates (including all candidates from BCN). Courses and activities from the providers below may request a (small) fee for participation. The GSMS supplies a training budget with a maximum of \pounds 600 per calendar year for participation in external courses (outside the GSMS), and another \pounds 600 for attending conferences.
